Thank you once again for your support over the first half term in what was a difficult and challenging time for us all.

We are going to ask for your support again as we react the news of South Staffordshire moving into Tier 2 from 31st October 2020.

As a school, we will now require all children in Year 7 and 8 (Key Stage 3) to actively wear face coverings when they are not in their classrooms or eating their lunch.

They will not be required to wear one when they are outside of school for example to and from school and break and lunch time.

We are aware that this is a big change, but we need to play our part in keeping all staff, pupils, parents, and carers safe in the coming weeks.

Please can we ask that you provide your child with a covering that is changed each day and that there is a zip bag for them to store them in when they are not being used. We will provide any pupil who does not have one with a single use face covering if it is needed.

Please could you discuss the importance of wearing this with your child and practice putting them on and removing them safely.
